A memorial sign will be installed at this site, and a dedication ceremony will take place in the near future. All Club members are cordially invited to attend this ceremony. The date and time of the ceremony will be printed in the newsletter when it is announced.

In regard to voting procedures, it is stated: "Voting for Club officers shall be by secret ballot unless waived by unanimous consent of the eligible voters present" (Article XI, Section 3). Finally, the vote for Club officers shall be by a "simple majority of members present and eligible to vote..." (Article XI, Section 4).
